grammar for teachers a guide to american english for native and non native speakers is a result of my frustrations over many years of teaching graduate level structure courses and not being able to find an appropriate grammar text for the pre and in service teachers enrolled in these classes the students in these courses have represented a variety of teaching backgrounds esl and efl teachers native and non nativespeakersof english and mainstreamcontent areateacherswith esl students in their classes to name a few some of these students have had a strong knowledge of english grammar but often have difficulties in applying their knowledge to real life discourse other students exposure has been limited to lessons in correctness and are generally unaware of which language features are central to teaching esl efl learners some students are resistant to taking this course but are required to do so whether to satisfy specific degree requirements for state or professional certification or for other reasons a few students have had some linguistics many not the challenge has been finding a way to convey the essentials of americanenglishgrammarclearly toengagestudentsactivelyin their own learning and understanding of grammar as applicable to esl efl learners and to motivate them to undertake perceptive analyses of grammatical elements and structures and of esl efl learner needs and difficulties the overall aim of grammar for teachers is to make grammar accessible and comprehensible
